

Dear visitors,

From July 1st we move on to the next fase. We have worked hard that a visit will be pleasant and safe for everyone.

Buy your tickets online in advance via the website. You have to book a day and a timeslot for your visit.

Do you have free entrance or a discount voucher? Please buy a 0-Euro ticket on the website and reserve a day and timeslot.

For the touchscreens in the museum, you can buy a stylus pen (online or at the museum). On some places in the museum there will be walking directions, signs and barriers. We will provide disinfectant dispensers at the entrance. Our staff will provide extra cleaning for the exhibitions and toilets.

All safety measures (status July 1st 2020)

- The Museon works with timeslots of 30 visitors per 15 minutes to ensure a safe distance of 1.5 meters (to another visitor who does not belong to the same household).
- It is not mandatory to reserve an e-ticket or timeslot in advance, but we recommend this so that you can be sure that you can enter at the desired time.
- We ask you to make cashless payments as much as possible.
- Stay home if you have one of the following symptoms: nasal cold, runny nose, sneezing, sore throat, light cough, elevation (up to 38 C°).
- Stay at home if someone in your household has a fever (38 C° and above) and/or shortness of breath, until everyone is symptom-free for 24 hours.
- Cough and sneeze in your elbow.
- Come alone, just the two of you, or with members from your household.
- Come, if possible, with your own transport.
- If you come by car, you can park in the garage of the World Forum, which is a 10 minutes walk from the Museon. Exit tickets are for sale on our ticket page.
Please note that the garage consists of two parts, we have exit tickets only for the part "entrance A" at Churchillplein and not for "entrance B" at the Johan de White Avenue.
- The back entrance of the Museon through the garden of Berlage is closed for public, access is only possible through the front door.
- Leave bags and (if the weather allows) coats at home as much as possible. At the moment the lockers cannot be used, but there is a guarded cloakroom at the Museon.
- Follow the indicated walking directions, the signs and the instructions of our staff.

- Stay together with your family/visitor group.
- Wearing a mouth mask is not mandatory.
- Guided tours are not yet possible.
- In the entire museum a maximum of 200 visitors are allowed at any given time.
- In the museum, visitors are free to walk around freely, taking into account the 1.5 metre rule, the museum uses a space of 10 m² for each visitor.
- The toilets may be used by family members of one family at a time. Our employees will supervise this. The toilets will be cleaned regularly.
- A visitor in a wheelchair can bring an assistant at their own risk.
- The use of the lift is possible for visitors who cannot walk stairs or people with a stroller. A maximum of two people are allowed in the lift.
- Our shop is open, based on the 1.5 meter rule.
- The Museumcafe is open, based on the 1.5 meter rule and the additional rules for the catering sector. Visitors can place orders at the cash register and pick up at the takeaway buffet. All products are available as takeaway.
